She presents her salon concerts internationally, recently in Moscow, Chicago, Seattle and, in 2014, New York, London and Vienna. She has sung in leading music festivals including Aspen, Chicago Humanities, International Festival Cardiff, Wales (BBC TV).

Raised abroad as the daughter of an American diplomat, Anna is a crossover artist who sings in five languages in styles ranging from pop to classical. She has garnered critical acclaim for her solo concerts at The Kennedy Center, Feinstein's, Caramoor, The Kravis Center and Colony Hotel (Palm Beach), Easthampton's Guild Hall, Westhampton Beach Performing Arts Center, Le Chat Noir (New Orleans), Manaus Opera House (Brazil), London's Café Royal and Jeremy King's The Crazy Coqs.

Favorite theatre/opera roles include Kate in **Kiss Me Kate**; Masha in **Three Sisters**; Guenevere in **Camelot**, Cordelia in **Falsettoland**; Lucy in **The Beggar's Opera**; Valencienne in **The Merry Widow**; and Rose in the world premiere opera **Blood On The Dining Room Floor**.

Anna is a graduate and fellow of Vassar College and the Aspen Music School.
